

Runners

Festuca rubra/Red Fescue, better for shade, often seen at the edge of golf course

✓ *Agrostis pallens*/Native Bentgrass, sun or some shade, lumpy and green

✓ *Carex pansa*/*Carex praegracilis*/Dune Sedge, sparser to fill in, possible lawn substitute (mowing to be kept short)

Leymus 'Canyon Prince' good for places where you need height, and can let it spread, very vigorous, stunning silvery blue foliage

But what about....(the ones I didn't mention)?

The rest...

✓ *Sisyrinchium bellam*/Blue Eyed Grass

✓ *Achillea millefolium* 'Island Pink' or 'Sonoma Coast'/Yarrow

Asclepias fascicularis/Narrow Leaf Milkweed

✓ *Verbena lilacina*/Lilac Verbena

✓ Any of our native buckwheats: *Eriogonum grande* var. *rubescens*, *E. fascicularis*, *E. giganteum*, *E. arborescens*

✓ *Salvia* 'Bee's Bliss', *Salvia sonomensis* (for shadier spots)

✓ *Erigeron glaucus* (Seaside Daisy)

✓ *Iris douglasiana*/Douglas Iris (afternoon shade preferred)

✓ *Ceanothus*/California Lilac

✓ *Arctostaphylos*/Manzanita

✓ Annual wildflowers such as *Eschscholzia californica*, *Clarkia*, etc...
